The Edmonton Golf Association has a long history in Edmonton. The first Men's tournament was held in 1921 and the first Ladies Tournament was held in 1935. The Ladies Association joined the EGA in 2003. Our four founding clubs, Victoria Golf Course, Edmonton Country Club, the Royal Mayfair, and Highlands will be recognized in our Centennial year.

The EGA seeks to be exemplary in its leadership and governance. A voluntary Board of Directors, comprised of elected representatives from member clubs meets on a regular basis together with frequent meetings of key

committees to ensure the ongoing progress and management of EGA events and activities.

The EGA has made aggressive and striking changes to reinvigorate itself and provide programs and support for golf in Edmonton. A Visioning meeting to connect with members, the hiring of an administrator, and enhanced communication are a few of these changes.

number of clinics to introduce new players to golf.
